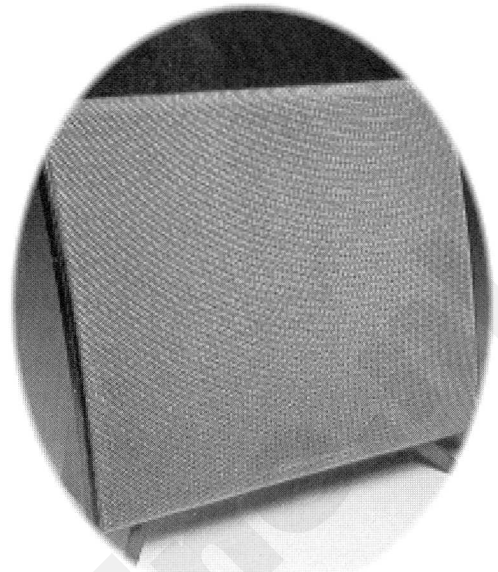


# Electrostatic Loudspeakers

## ESL-57

### Features

- The world's first commercial full range electrostatic loudspeaker. Originally called the Quad ELS but now usually referred to as the ESL-57.
- It was first manufactured in 1957.
- Capable of very high quality reproduction at normal domestic listening levels and still very highly regarded – the only better loudspeaker being the Quad ESL-63!

### Specifications

Maximum Output:	93dB on axis in free space in frequency range 50 Hz-10kHz (referred to 0.0002 dynes/cm <sup>2</sup> )
Impedance:	30-15 ohms in range 40Hz-8kHz (falling above 8kHz)
