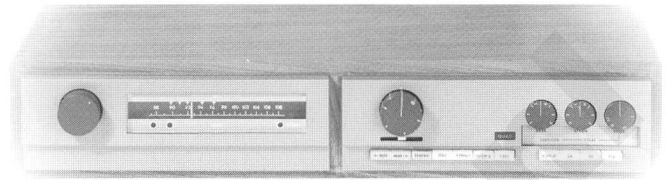


FM3 Tuner (production from 1971-1982)

Features

- High quality stereo FM (VHF) tuner. Simple operation as the only front panel control is for station tuning which can also be used for setting the movable station markers (useful for station location).
- Has a large clear tuning scale and indicator lamps show when it is accurately tuned to a station and when a stereo signal is being received.
- There is a preset noise suppression control at the rear which when correctly set enables for silent tuning between stations.
